Dear 8th Grade Parents,

A new year for Faith Formation has arrived. Read through the below information to familiarize yourself with our program.

- 1) All Faith Formation related forms can be found at the www.churchofsttimothy.org webpage under the faith formation tab for easy print out. (For those who cannot print out forms they will be available in the Parish Office, Church Entrance Ways, and at the Open House.
- 2) 8th Grade is a special year in our program, the students are taught the Theology of the Body: For Teens. On Tuesday, September 3rd there will be two options for the Parental Meeting. The first will run from 5:30pm-6:10pm. The second will run from 7:10-7:50pm.
- 3) Our late fee for faith formation is \$10 this year. Be sure to have all payment and all forms in by the Open House, Sep 4th.
- 4) If your child has any unique educational needs or allergies please communicate them to us via the registration form.
- 5) If your child is absent from school on a Wednesday due to a sickness do not send them to Faith Formation Wednesday night. If your child will miss a Faith Formation session please let us know ahead of time via phone call, e-mail, or text message

Again, return Faith Formation forms with full payment (FF tuition, and any applicable retreat fees) by the Open House on September 4th from 6-7:00pm. Your materials may also be returned by mail, delivered in person to the parish office, or placed in the weekend collection in an envelope marked FF registration.

The catechist for 8th grade this year will be Joe Ackerman. They look forward to meeting you at the Open House & seeing you throughout the year. We welcome any opportunity to be with the parents and learn more from you and more about the students we will be serving.

Classes will be offered for 8th grade from 7pm-8:15pm on Wednesdays **in the school building** (use front entrance). Our 8th graders will make two retreats this year, our first is the NET Retreat which takes place on **Wednesday, January 15th** from 4-9pm. The second takes place on March 7th. Both are mandatory. If these retreats do not work with your schedule please communicate this fact to me as soon as possible. I will help you find alternatives.

If you have any questions please don't hesitate to ask. I am excited for the new year and look forward to seeing our children grow in their relationship with Jesus & His Church.

ST. TIMOTHY'S FAITH FORMATION CODE OF CONDUCT

Catechists of Faith Formation perform an invaluable service to the parents of St. Timothy's Parish. They have a time-consuming and challenging job, as you can well imagine. They need to cover volumes of material in just one hour a week and it's often frustrating. Your responsibility as parents is to deliver and pick up your teenager on time, to discuss with them the content covered in class, and to assure teachers of his/her consistent, appropriate behavior.

Even though infrequent, any serious attitude/discipline problems make it necessary - for the success of our program - that all parents and their students sign a behavior contract that will be strictly enforced. Every young person in faith formation is entitled to quality instruction in a supportive and safe environment.

Our policy states that: **when the adult leader considers a student's behavior to be consistently off task, inappropriate or disrespectful, that student will receive one verbal warning. Any subsequent problem will be reported to the Director of Faith Formation. Parents will be contacted before the next class period to choose one of two options:**

- A. Parents will receive leader guides and training to home school their student. A follow-up quiz will be given by the Director of Faith Formation
- B. Parents will accompany their student to his/her class to assist with instruction and behavior.

If the behavior is severe there will be no other warnings and appropriate action will happen that night when the parent picks up the student.

Parent or Guardian: I agree that my young person shall abide by the contract outlined above. I have reviewed it and discussed the contract with my child prior to signing this form. I agree that if my child fails to consistently abide by the code or engages in a serious infraction of the code, I will be notified immediately to choose from the options listed above.
