Please continue to come forward in the same manner as before, one communion line in each of the side aisles, one section at a time, and maintaining safe distancing. Once you have received, please return to your pew for prayer and the final blessing.

When exiting, the sections nearest the baptismal font and St Joseph's altar will use the side door toward the chapel, the sections nearest the ambo and the Mary's altar will exit out the back of the church as before. Please do not congregate in the church after Mass and continue to maintain distancing.

Thanks again for your cooperation. By following the Archdiocesan guidelines, we are each doing our part to help keep our parish safe, which then allows us to slowly return to the pre-COVID practices we are used to.
