FIRST SATURDAY MASS

Mass at 8:00 am with Rosary and Confessions one-half hour before Mass. After Mass there will be a general blessing of religious articles followed by a blessing for expectant mothers near Saint Mary's altar. Following the blessings, devotional prayers to our Mother of Perpetual Help and Benediction will begin.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Confessions held Wednesday and Friday, one half hour before Mass, Saturday from 3:30-4:15 pm and at the parish office by appointment.

PERPETUAL EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

Eucharistic Adoration takes place 24 hours a day in the Adoration Chapel.

MARRIAGE

Contact the parish priest at least one year in advance to arrange marriage. No weddings during the Lenten season.

BAPTISM

Baptisms are celebrated the first Sunday of the month, following the 10:00 am Mass. A baptismal preparation program is required and parish registration expected. Contact the parish office for information and to schedule.

BLESSING OF PREGNANT MOTHERS - LAST WEEKEND OF THIS MONTH AT ALL MASSES (OCTOBER 30-31)

For the last 16 years the Blessing of Pregnant Mothers was offered on a monthly basis after First Saturday morning Mass. The last few years there has been a decrease of mothers presenting themselves for a blessing which is why it will now be offered at all Masses on the last weekend of the month on a quarterly basis. The general blessing for pregnant mothers will be before the dismissal at each Mass on October 30-31. Following Mass mothers are encouraged to go to the Blessed Virgin Mary altar for a holy card of the patron for pregnant mothers (mothers can choose between St. Gerard or St. Gianna). 
