Dear Sixth Grade Parents,

Please read through the below information as we prepare for a new year of Faith Formation

- 1) The Faith Formation Open House will be Aug. 30th from 6-7:30pm at the school building. The catechist look forward to meeting all of the kids this year!
- 2) All Faith Formation related forms can be found through email, on the church website under the Faith Formation tab, and the church foyer.
- 3) Turn in all Faith Formation forms for 2023-24 at the same time.
 - a. Registration Sheet (double sided)
 - b. Code of conduct (one per child 6th grade and older is needed)
 - c. Parental involvement (only one per family is needed)
 - d. Authorization, Consent Release for Use of Visual Likeness and Original Works of Minors
 - e. Novel Coronavirus Acknowledgement and Assumption of Risk.
- 4) Late submission fee is \$10. This applies after August 31st.
- 5) If your child has any <u>unique educational needs or allergies please communicate them</u> to us via the registration form.
- 6) If your child is absent from school on Wednesday due to a sickness do not send them to Faith Formation Wednesday night.
- 7) If your child will miss a Faith Formation session, please let us know ahead of time via phone or e-mail
- 8) The Net Retreat is set for September 25th, 3:30pm-9:00pm at the church. This is a required retreat.
- 9) Nitty Gritty Details
 - a. The program will start at 4:30pm. We will be using the side doors of the building again this year. The doors to the classroom will only be opened at 4:25 in order to give catechists some prep time and also allow for their meeting. Students are to stay with their parents in their cars until 4:25. They are <u>not</u> allow to hang out at the park unattended due to the After School program using it at that time. At 4:25, they can then make their way to their classroom.
 - b. At 5:45pm, the children will be released to walk to the parking lot to wait for their parents. If you prefer your child not be released without you, please let me know. If you are choosing to not get out of your car when picking them up, please drive up along the curve and wait for them so they are not running through the parking lot.
 - i. As before, we cannot send children out into the parking lot on their own.
- 10) Homeschooling is an option that can be handled on a family by family basis.

Also, I would like to remind you that we have Open Youth Room at the church on Wednesdays, after school until 7:00pm. This is available for any students, 6th-12th grade, who wants to find community at the parish and also needs a place to go after school until classes. They have time to play games, enjoy Adoration, and have a meal provided every week. It is an amazing opportunity!

If you have any questions please don't hesitate to ask. I am excited for the new year and look forward to seeing our children grow in their relationship with Jesus & His Church.

ST. TIMOTHY'S FAITH FORMATION CODE OF CONDUCT

Catechists of Faith Formation perform an invaluable service to the parents of St. Timothy's Parish. They have a time-consuming and challenging job, as you can well imagine. They need to cover much material in just over one hour a week. Your responsibility as parents is to deliver and pick up your teenager on time, to discuss with them the content covered in class, and to assure teachers of his/her consistent, appropriate behavior.

Even though infrequent, any serious attitude/discipline problems make it necessary - for the success of our program - that all parents and their students sign a behavior contract that will be strictly enforced. Every young person in faith formation is entitled to quality instruction in a supportive and safe environment.

Our policy states that: when the adult leader considers a student's behavior to be <u>consistently</u> off task, inappropriate or disrespectful, that student will receive one verbal warning. Any subsequent problem will be reported to the Director of Faith Formation. Parents will be contacted before the next class period to choose one of two options:

- A. Parents will receive leader guides and training to home school their student. A follow-up quiz will be given by the Director of Faith Formation
- B. Parents will accompany their student to his/her class to assist with instruction and behavior. If the behavior is severe there will be no other warnings and appropriate action will happen that night when the parent picks up the student.

Parent or Guardian: I agree that my young person shall abide by the contract outlined above. I have reviewed it and discussed the contract with my child prior to signing this form. I agree that if my child fails to consistently abide by the code or engages in a serious infraction of the code, I will be notified immediately to choose from the options listed above.


